WRLA is results-proven. According to graduate impact outcomes:

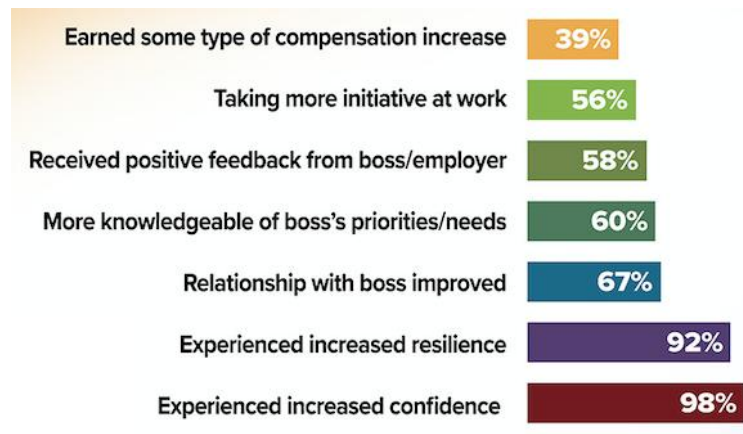
- 98% report increased confidence
